# Spring 2023 Testing Results

#### Grade Equivalency Scores of Visitation Catholic School Students

Grade Equivalency Scores indicate the level of work that our students can complete. The students take the Iowa Assessments in April. Since April is the eighth month of the school year, a 4th grade student taking the test would be at a grade level of 4.8. If this 4th grade student received a Grade Level Equivalency of 6.6 in reading, that indicates how a 6th grade student in the sixth month of school would be expected to score on that 4th grade test. It does not mean that this particular 4th grade student can do work from the sixth month of sixth grade. The highest grade level that can be achieved is 13+. For the classes that have taken more than one Iowa Assessment, the last two sets of scores are included for comparison.
